

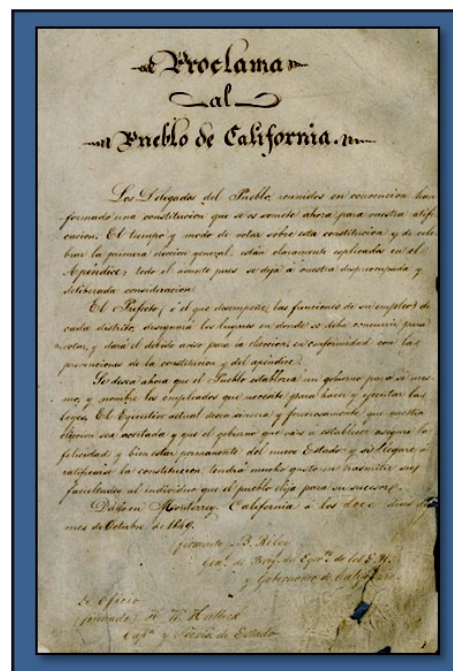
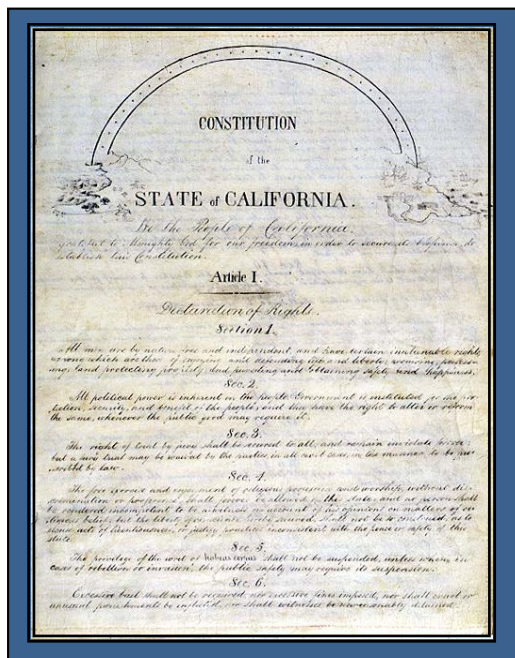
California Admission Day
